Setting up Mac Mail

- 1. Open up Mail.app and press Command+Comma to invoke the Preferences window.
- 2. Switch to the "Accounts" pane and press the + button in the lower-left corner.
- 3. Under "Account Information", fill out the following information:
 - Account Type: POP
 - Email Address: email-name@your-domain-name.com
 - Incoming Mail Server: mail. *your-domain-name.com*
 - Username: *email-name@your-domain-name.com*
 - Password: *your email password*
 - Note that POP uses port 110
- 4. Select "Add Server..." from the **Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)** pop-up menu. Here are the details for it:
 - Outgoing Mail Server: mail. *your-domain-name.com*
 - Server port: 25
 - Use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL): NO
 - Authentication: password
 - User Name: *email-name@your-domain-name.com*
 - Password: your email password
 - Dismiss the window by pressing "OK."
- 5. Back in the "Accounts" pane, switch to the "Advanced" tab and do not check the box marked "Use SSL" towards the bottom.
